The Details:

1. Investigate what the people are talking about. Find a recent science article (within 30 days) in a newspaper, magazine, or web site of supreme quality and trustworthy reputation (CNN, Earth News, Discovery, NOVA, Science Daily, etc.). The story should be related to science in some way, and illuminate new findings and discoveries by those who are working in the field. (Topics of interest could be; plants, animals, physics, space, weather, chemistry, health, I could go on.....

but find something that is interesting to YOU!

2. Report the source of your info. Cut out the article or print the story from the net or simply site your source in the proper format. I.E. Tell headquarters where your information is coming from.
3. Prepare to brief the president. Write a 1-2 paragraph summary of the key points and the significance **in your own words**. Key points include; who, what, when, where, why should anyone care.
